HOW CAN YOU TRAVEL THE WORLD (WITHOUT LEAVING HOME)?

1. Look at a world map and select a destination that you've always wanted to travel to.
2. Choose the most direct or most interesting way to get there and calculate costs. Consider gas prices and tolls if you're driving or ticket prices for buses, trains, and/or flights.
3. Research and plan your itinerary! Where would you sleep? What would you see? What would you eat? How long would you stay? Estimate how much each day would cost if you were to actually embark on this adventure.
4. Shift from trip planner to tourist and take advantage of as many free virtual opportunities as possible. Explore the region and walk around using Google Maps, visit exhibitions on museum websites, use a language app, or watch a movie that takes place in the location you selected.
